

Accepted Digital Formats

General Requirements: Provide a high-resolution PDF of your completed advertisement that is compliant with PDF/X-1a:2001. Export your ads using the PDF/X-1a:2001 settings with compatibility set to version 1.3. High resolution .jpg, .png, or .eps files are also acceptable (must be sized to the provided specs). File must contain only one page.

Supported Applications: Ad can be created in any application capable of exporting to PDF/X-1a:2001 standards. We recommend Adobe InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop, Quark XPress, Canva, etc. DO NOT create ads in Microsoft Word, Publisher or other word processing programs. Photos and graphics in ads should be 300dpi minimum.

Although we prefer to use your PDF file, we may require 'native files' if the PDF is not X-1a complaint or has other issues. If this is the case, we will contact you to provide the original files. Additional charges may apply for ads submitted not adhering to the guidelines above.

File Naming: When naming your ad, please use NAAIA and advertiser's name plus ad size. Ex: NAAIA–ABC Corp Half Page
